

## EQUUSOMA™ Approved Providers and Assistants

As a pre-requisite to attending an intensive, training participants are required to complete 10 hours of personal sessions of either a) Somatic Experiencing® (with or without the involvement of horses) or b) equine-assisted therapy/learning (with or without integrating Somatic Experiencing®), depending on their scope of practice. For those who are specifically interested in completing their hours with a practitioner who combines SE™ and equine-assisted practice, the following list of practitioners has been pre-approved to support students in the EQUUSOMA™ training.
